CRITERIA FOR SELECTION: 1) Graduate Student status; 2) Preparation in the relevant subjects; 3) Achievement in the relevant subjects; 4) Potential to be an effective teacher of UW undergraduates. *EPS students strongly preferred.*

DESCRIPTION OF PRINCIPAL DUTIES: Independent instruction of a single section of EPS 300: School and Society during the spring semester of the 2017-2018 academic year. Lecture 001 will meet Monday and Wednesday afternoons from 4:00-5:15 PM. Lecture 002 will meet Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30-10:45AM. Lectures 003 will meet Tuesday and Thursdays from 2:30 – 3:45PM. Lectures 004 will meet Thursdays from 2:25-5:25PM (MC-EA/ESL).

Candidates must submit the following materials to be considered:

- 1) Letter of application detailing relevant qualifications and indicating which lecture you are interested in;
- 2) Ranking preference list if you are applying to multiple vacancies;
- 3) Copy of graduate transcripts;
- 4) At least one current letter of reference from a UW-Madison or other university faculty member;
- 5) Curriculum vita;
- 6) Draft syllabus for the course;

It is the responsibility of the candidate to gather the above materials and submit them in a timely fashion.

The letter of reference should speak to the candidate's qualifications to serve as a Student Assistant Lecturer in EPS 300.

Student appointments to receive departmental assistance will be withdrawn if the student is carrying more than 1 incomplete after August 1, for a fall start date, and January 10 for a spring start date. Exceptions to this policy must be agreed upon by the full faculty.
